TOP DOG 2024 COMPETITION STARTS 4 AUG

The Qualifying Round is combined net and is on Sun 4 Aug at 8am for 8.30 start off the first tee from the blue markers.

The Top Dog competition rounds involve teams of two playing against other teams on a seeded draw using four-ball match play on 90% handicap. You and your partner compete together as a side, with each of you playing your own ball, and your side's score for a hole is the lower net score of the two of you on that hole on handicap. Select your partner and register at the Golf Shop. The registration sheet, poster and competition rules will be displayed on the Golf Shop noticeboard on Wednesday this week. The competition rounds are on or before 11 Aug, 18 Aug, 25 Aug, 1 Sep, 15 Sep (final). More information will be in the Rules Poster.



BECOME A GOLF RULES OFFICIAL & REFEREE

North Golf has extended an invitation to Northland golfers to undertake training courses to become qualified rules officials/referees in Northland. Golf NZ will deliver the level 2 course, most likely over one full day or two if necessary. Anyone registering for the course will need to complete the online Level 1 exam prior to the course.
