SLOW PLAY - THE SCOURGE OF GOLF PLAY

There appears to be pockets of slow play evident on most days across the course but especially on Saturdays and Sundays. Slow play is unacceptable and must be minimised. Here are some points to help keep the pace up. Ways to improve the pace of play:

- Arrive at the course having organised yourself and equipment properly.
- Arrive at the course to be able to play when it is your turn.
- Keep pre-shot routines in check complete them before it is your turn to play.
- If in doubt play a provisional ball.
- Wave people through sooner.
- Be ready and efficient at the green get your preliminaries done before it is your turn to chip or putt.
- Don't leave clubs on or around the green that require you to return to the green.



- Mark cards at the right time, not on the green or near it - do it whilst you are waiting for your shot at the next tee.
- Watch where you hit and where your ball comes to rest. Note any markers as to where your ball is.
- The recommended time for a shot is 40 seconds and 3 minutes to find a ball.
- Play ready golf and play your shot or putt if the person furthest from the pin is a long time in coming.
- Don't talk to other golfers that will use up time whilst you should be playing.
- Walk with a keen sense of urgency.
