Well done Northland Golf Club and thank you to all the staff and volunteers who assisted in making this a very successful day.



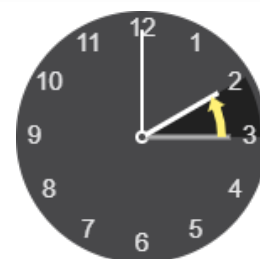
### LOST PROPERTY - YOUR STUFF MISSES YOU TOO!
