RULES OF GOLF 2023	PENNANTS - PLAYERS NEEDED
Many of us have applied a rule because others have used the rule but not really knowing if a rule is correct. For example, playing a provisional ball when you know 98 percent that your ball entered a red penalty area. The practice has "become the rule" in many cases, when in fact the use of a provisional ball in this case is not an option. There is a penalty for doing this – what is it? North Golf has offered clubs the opportunity to have a qualified referee visit and conduct a theory and practical session on rules issues and the application of rules in general.
